

SETTLEMENT

(James Douglas Jackson and Donald Alexander Smith
v. Attorney General of Canada, Court File No.: CP15454/04)

If you were or are employed by the Correctional Service of Canada at the Joyceville Institution and your name appeared on an Employee Address Listing in February, 2001 this notice may affect your rights. Please read this Notice carefully.

On August 23, 2010, the Ontario Superior Court of Justice approved a Settlement of claims related to the above-noted lawsuit that requires the Correctional Service of Canada (the "CSC") to make a payment of money known as a "Compromise Payment" to the Class Members as defined below. This settlement is made as a compromise and does not constitute an admission of liability by the CSC. Further to this Settlement the CSC has set aside a further "pool" of funds that are available to those Class Members below who suffered a Compensable Claim for a serious psychological condition or a recognized psychiatric illness directly attributable to the notice from officials of the CSC that the Employee Address Listing had been found in the possession of at least one inmate on or about December, 2003.

The Class Members are defined as follows:

All persons who were employees of the Correctional Services of Canada at the Joyceville Institution near Kingston, Ontario whose names, addresses, telephone numbers and any other related personal information was contained on a list ("the Employee Address Listing") that was let into the possession of inmates of the said Institution during the period of August 2003 to December 2003 inclusive and the spouses of those said employees during that time.

As a member of the class above, nothing is required in order for you to receive the Compromise Payment referred to above. The CSC will contact employees of the CSC at their last known address in order to administer payment. However, if you are a member of the class of persons as described above who may have suffered a Compensable Claim, immediate action is required on your part. YOU MUST APPLY TO BE CONSIDERED FOR COMPENSATION FROM THE POOL OF FUNDS BY NO LATER THAN NOVEMBER 23, 2010.
